

Winter Storm Safety Rules

By planning ahead of the storm, you'll be prepared in the event of severe winter weather in your area.

Be Prepared!

- **Stay informed.** Listen to NOAA Weather Radio, commercial radio, or television for the latest on the storm.
- **Do not plan to travel during the height of the storm.** Leave early, or wait until the storm is over. Make sure your car is winterized ensuring all parts are in good working order and that you begin any trip with a full tank of gas.
- **Plan to telecommute for work, if possible.** Some employers allow telecommuting during hazardous weather.
- **Check ahead with your airline.** Flights may be delayed or canceled during the storm.
- **Ensure food and medical supplies are adequate.** You may not be able to travel.
- **Check your supply of heating fuel.** Be careful when using alternative heating sources due to the risk of carbon monoxide and fire.
